#### Tools

- 3.5mm Bamboo Knitting Needles Takumi® Single Pointed (23 cm) (Art No. 3707)
- Gold Eye chenille Needle (No. 18) (Art No. 234/18)
- Double-Ended Stitch Holder, Small (Art No. 351)
- Patchwork Scissors(Mini) (Art no. 493/CW)
- 2 cm Pom-Pom Maker(optional)
   (Art No. 3127 Extra Small)

#### Materials

- [A] 15g light brown DK (8-ply)
- [B] Small amount of white DK
- [C] 5g red DK
- [D] Small amount of fleecy yarn white DK
- A pair of 6mm eye beads, black cotton thread
- Small amount of 4-ply dark brown
- Stuffing

### Tension

• 24 sts x 30 = 10cm measured over St st (not essential)

## Yarn used for the sample

- Light Brown: DK, 50g per 155m, 40% Nylon, 30% Wool, 30% Acrylic
- White: DK, 50g per 165m, 55 % Nylon, 45% Acrylic
- Fleecy white: DK, 25g per 85m, 100% Polyester

### <Abbreviations>

St st: stocking stitch Kfb: k one through the front then through the back (same stitch)

St(s): stitch(es) K2tog: knit two together
K: knit K3tog: knit three together

WS: wrong side RS: right side

## <Practical tips>

P: purl

- Leave a long end at the beginning and end for sewing.
- Sew seam with the right side facing out, using mattress stitch.
- Attach eye beads before stuffing head if you are using safety eyes with washers.

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#### **BODY**

With A, cast on 10 sts.

Row 1 (WS): Purl.

Row 2: [Kfb] in each st to end. 20 sts

Row 3: Purl.

Row 4: [K1, kfb] to end. 30 sts

Row 5: Purl.

Row 6: [K2, kfb] to end. 40 sts

Rows 7-17: Starting with a p row, work 11 rows in St st.

Row 18: [K2, k2tog] to end. 30 sts

Rows 19-29: Starting with a p row, work 11 rows in St st.

Row 30: [K1, k2tog] to end. 20 sts

Rows 31-35: Starting with a p row, work 5 rows in St st.

Row 36: [K2tog] to end. 10 sts

Break yarn, draw through sts, pull tightly and fasten off.

### **HEAD**

Work as for Body to row 17. 40 sts

Row 18 (eyeline): K10 [k2tog] 10 times, k10. 30 sts. Break A.

Rows 19-23: Join B and starting with a p row, work 5 rows in St st.

Row 24: [K1, k2tog] to end. 20 sts

Rows 25-27: Starting with a p row, work 3 rows in St st.

Break yarn, draw through sts, pull tightly and fasten off.

ARMS: make two

With A, cast on 7 sts.

Row 1 (WS): Purl.

Row 2: [Kfb] in each st to end. 14 sts

Rows 3-15: Starting with a p row, work 13 rows in St st.

Row 16: [K2tog] to end. 7 sts

Break yarn, draw through sts, pull tightly and fasten off.



LEGS: make two

With B, cast on 10 sts.

Row 1 (WS): Purl.

Row 2: [Kfb] in each st to end. 20 sts

Row 3: Purl. Break B.

Rows 4-7: Join A and starting with a k row, work 4 rows in St st.

Row 8 (ankle): K7 [k2tog] three times, k7. 17 sts

Row 9: Purl.

Row 10: K7, k3tog, k7. 15 sts

Rows 11-17: Starting with a p row, work 7 rows in st st.

Row 18: K1, [k2tog] to end. 8 sts

Break yarn, draw through sts, pull tightly and fasten off.

EARS: make two in A, two in B.

With A/B, cast on 14 sts.

Row 1 (WS): Purl.

Row 2: [K2tog] to end. 7 sts

Break yarn, draw through sts, pull tightly and fasten off.

### **HAT**

With D, cast on 40 sts.

Rows 1-2: Knit. Break D.

Row 3 (RS): Join C and knit.

Row 4 (ear hole): P14, cast off next 3 sts, p5, cast off next 3 sts, p13. 34 sts

Row 5: K14, cast on 3 sts, k6, cast on 3 sts, k14. 40 sts

Rows 6-8: Starting with a p row, work 3 rows in St st.

Row 9: [K2, k2tog] to end. 30 sts

Rows 10-18: Starting with a p row, work 9 rows in St st.

Row 19: [K1, k2tog] to end. 20 sts

Rows 20-26: Starting with a p row, work 7 rows in St st.

Row 27: [K2tog] to end. 10 sts

Rows 28-32: Starting with a p row, work 5 rows in St st.

Row 33: [K2tog] to end. 5 sts

Break yarn, draw through sts, pull tightly and fasten off.



#### **VEST**

With D, cast on 30 sts.

Rows 1-2: Knit.

Row 3 (RS): K3D, join C and k24C, join another strand of D and k3D.

Row 4: K3D, p24C, k3D.

Rows 5-6: Repeat rows 3-4.

Row 7 (armhole): K3D, k3C, cast off next 3 sts, k11C, cast off next 3 sts, k2C, k3D. 24 sts

### **Left front**

Row 8 (WS): K3D, p3C, turn.

Row 9: K3C, k3D, turn. Row 10: K3D, p3C, turn.

Row 11: K3C, k3D. Place these sts on a holder.

### **Centre back**

Row 8 (WS): With WS facing, join C and p12, turn.

Row 9: K12, turn.

Row 10:P12, turn.

Row 11: K12, turn. Place these sts on a holder.

### **Right front**

Row 8 (WS): P3C, k3D, turn.

Row 9:K3D, k3C, turn.

Row 10:P3C, k3D, turn.

Row 11: K3D, k3C. Place these sts on a holder.

Row 12 (WS): With WS facing, join yarns and k3D, p3C, cast on 2 sts, p12, cast on 2 sts, p3C, k3D. 28 sts

Row 13: K3D, k22C, k3D.

Row 14: K3D, p22C, k3D.

Row 15: K3D, with C, k4, [K2tog, k4] three times, k3D. 25 sts Break C.

Rows 16-17: With D, knit

Cast off k-wise.

### Pompom: make three

Wind each side of pompom maker 50 times, using B.

Cut between disks, tie centre firmly and cut loops. Trim.



#### TO MAKE UP

With fastened-off yarn end, seam Head half way.

With cast-on yarn end, work a gathering thread along cast-on edge and draw tightly.

Stuff and close seam.

With A, work a gathering thread over eyeline and draw gently to shape dent.

Sew front and back of Ears together at side edges and attach them to Head.

Attach eyes. With 4-ply dark brown, embroider nose.

Make up Body as Head, working from fastened-off and cast-on edge.

Stuff. Seam and stuff Arms and Legs.

Thread A and pierce foot from sole, take out from ankle and repeat.

Pull thread to flatten sole and shape ankle.

Attach Arms and Legs to body.

Seam Hat and attach pompom to the tip.

Place some stuffing inside, put it on the Head and squeeze Ears through holes.

Secure Hat to Head with stitches all around.

Attach Head to Body.

Prepare 2 strings of B cut to about 12 cm and attach pompom to each end.

Attach strings to front of Vest.

Dress bear in Vest and tie bow at front.
